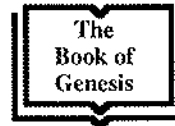

Key Verse

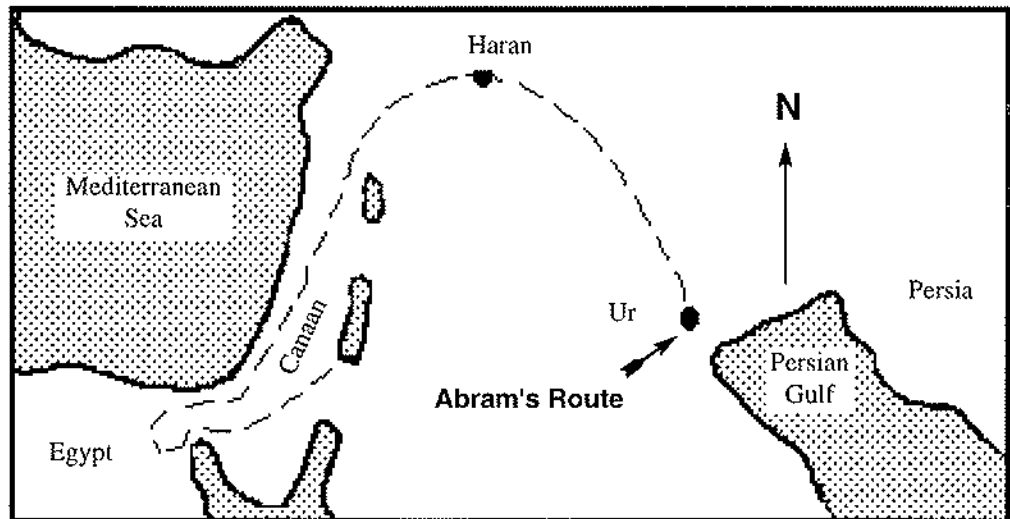
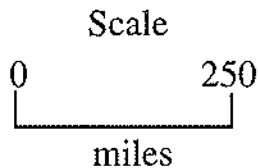
Hebrews 11: 8

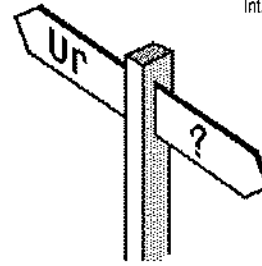
Trusting is a very important word in the Bible, but what does it mean?
