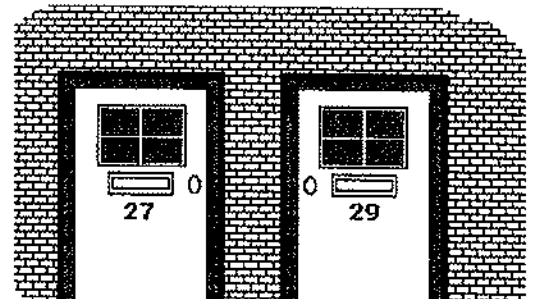
Lesson No. 1 Parables - Who is my Neighbour?
