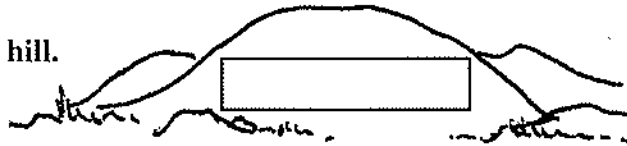
What part did Simon of Cyrene play in the events of that day?

 3. The answer he received *from* Jesus in verse 43.

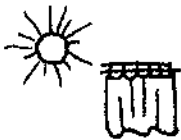
