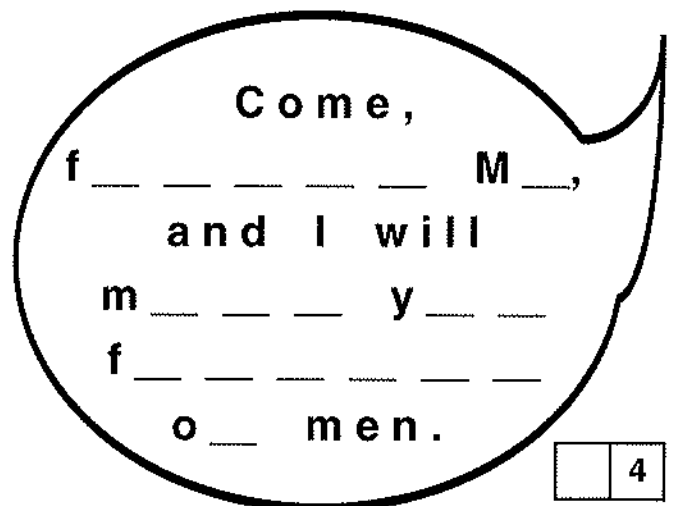
The two fishermen were throwing their net into the water in the hope of catching some fish. Jesus saw how busily they were working and knew that they were the sort of men who could be a help to Him.

**What did Jesus say to the fishermen?**

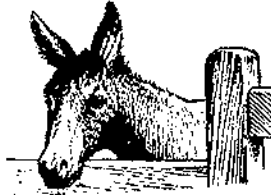

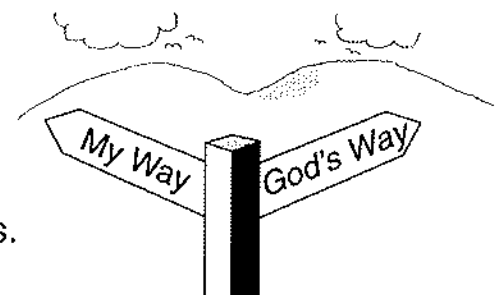
