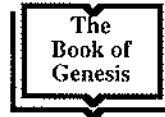

22: 1-9

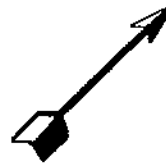


Genesis 22: 8

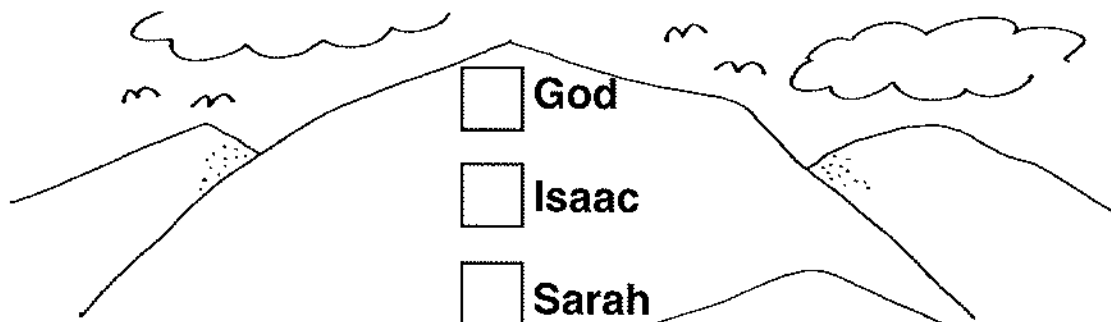

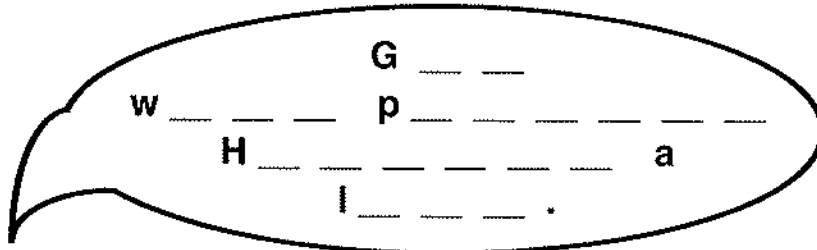
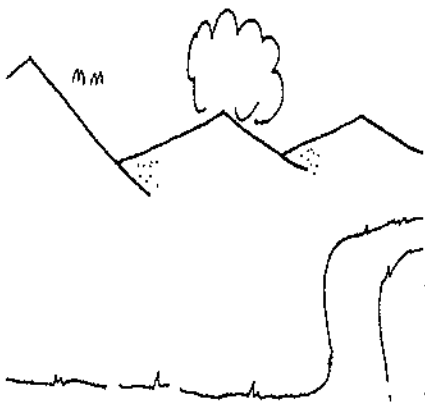
