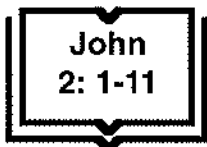

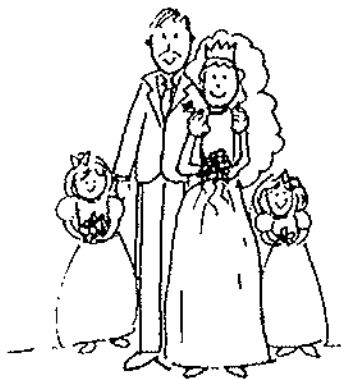
## Story 1 - Jesus changes water into wine.
