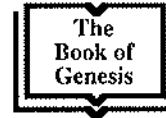

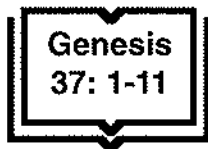

Do you belong to a big family? Joseph certainly did! He had ten brothers who were older than he was, and one brother who was younger, and one sister.

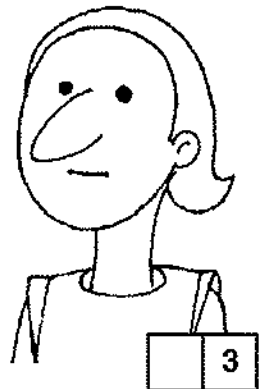
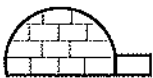
How many boys were in the family altogether?

Write down the first letter of each object to discover Jacob's other name.

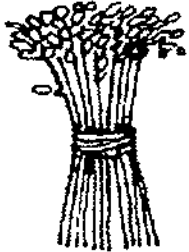

Because Jacob loved Joseph so much, he gave him a lovely coat. It had many colours. Perhaps it was like this.

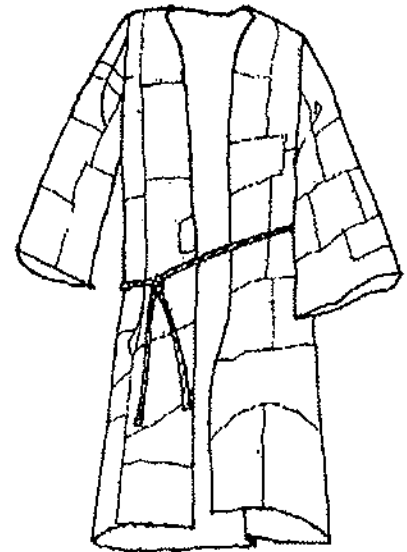
Colour it carefully.

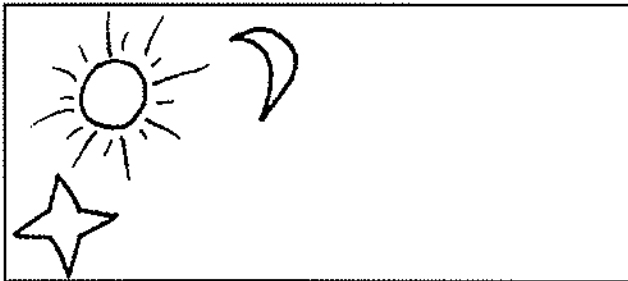
