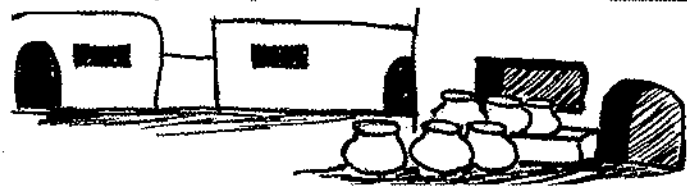
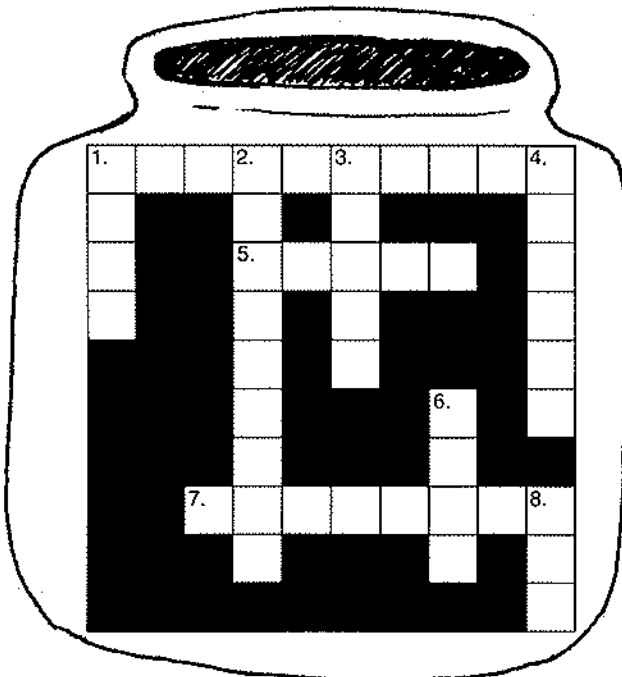
Clues Across
