What was the special sign of which Isaiah spoke?

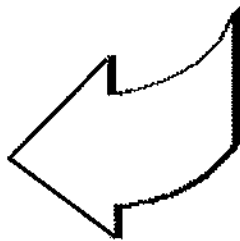
