*Genesis 13: 1-18*

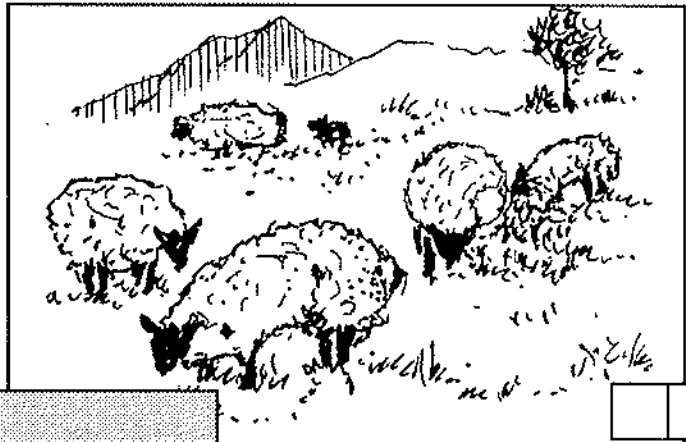
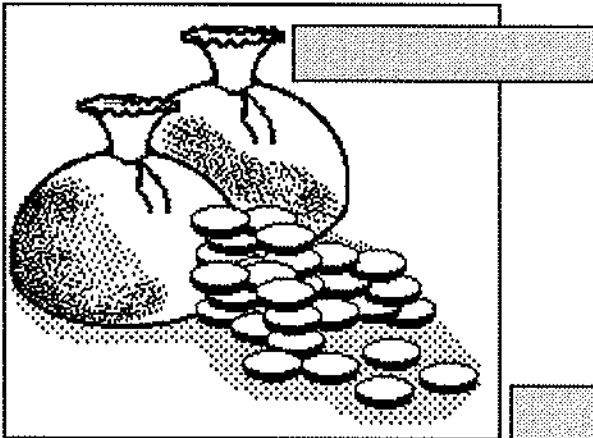
**Key Verse**

To hit someone who hurts us. / To forgive them.

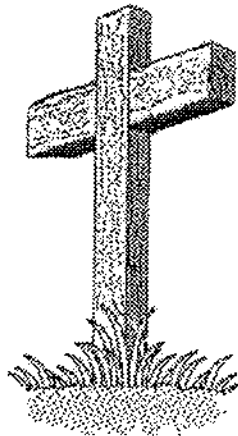
