John 4: 43-54

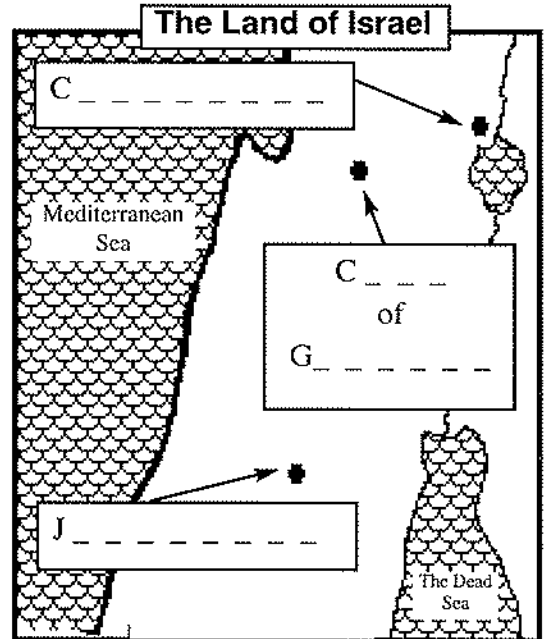
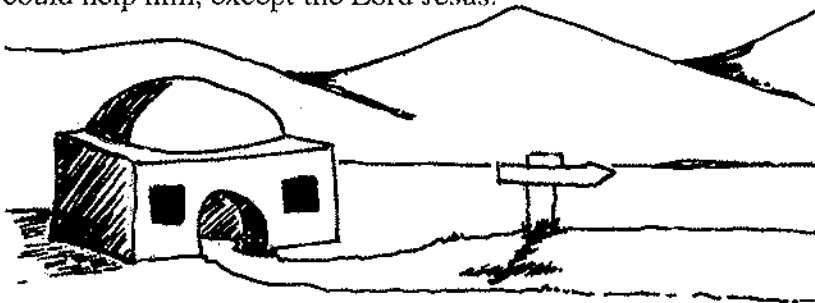


Key Verse

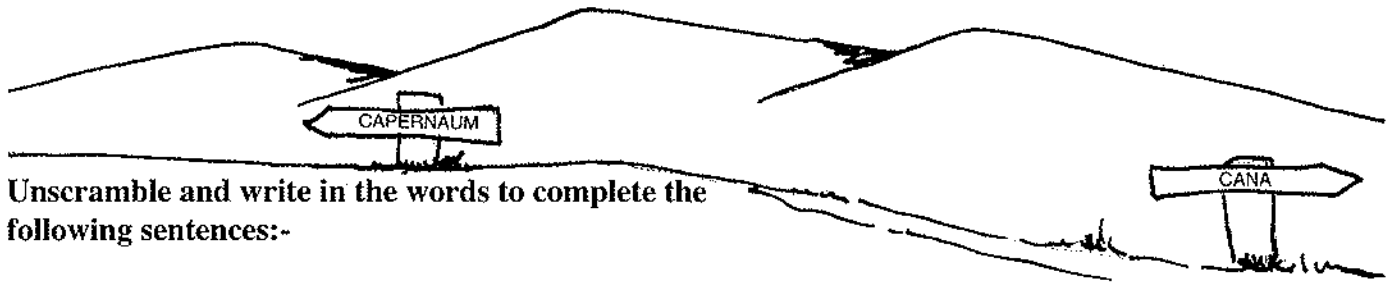

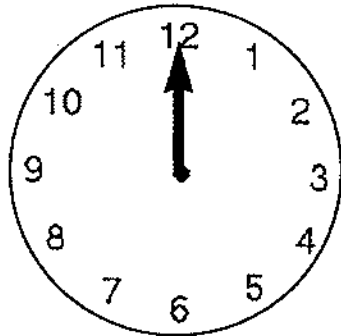

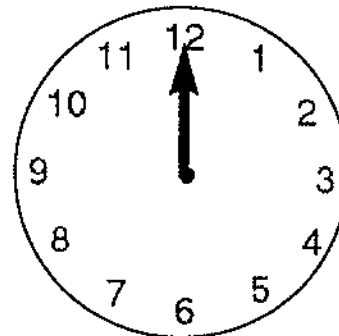
