In a little while both men

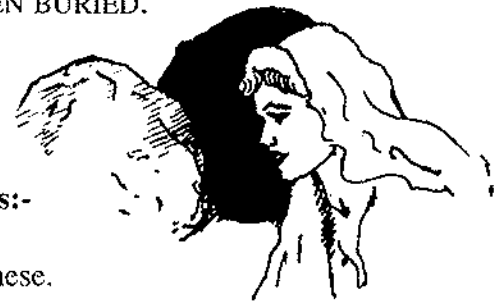
**SAT DOWN TO WAIT FOR MARY / FELL ASLEEP / WENT HOME.**
