2. The breadth or width of the idol?

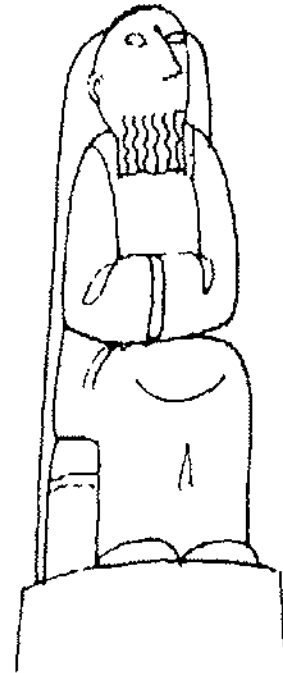

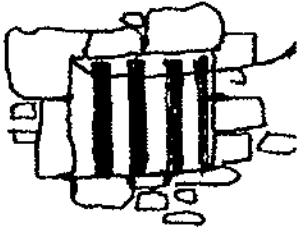
The herald proclaimed what everyone had to do once the idol was finished.

Read verses 13 & 14 and write in the boxes, who it was who refused to bow down to the idol.

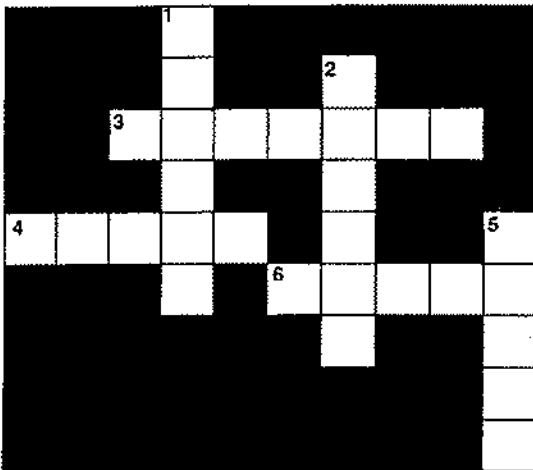
