Luke 5: 10

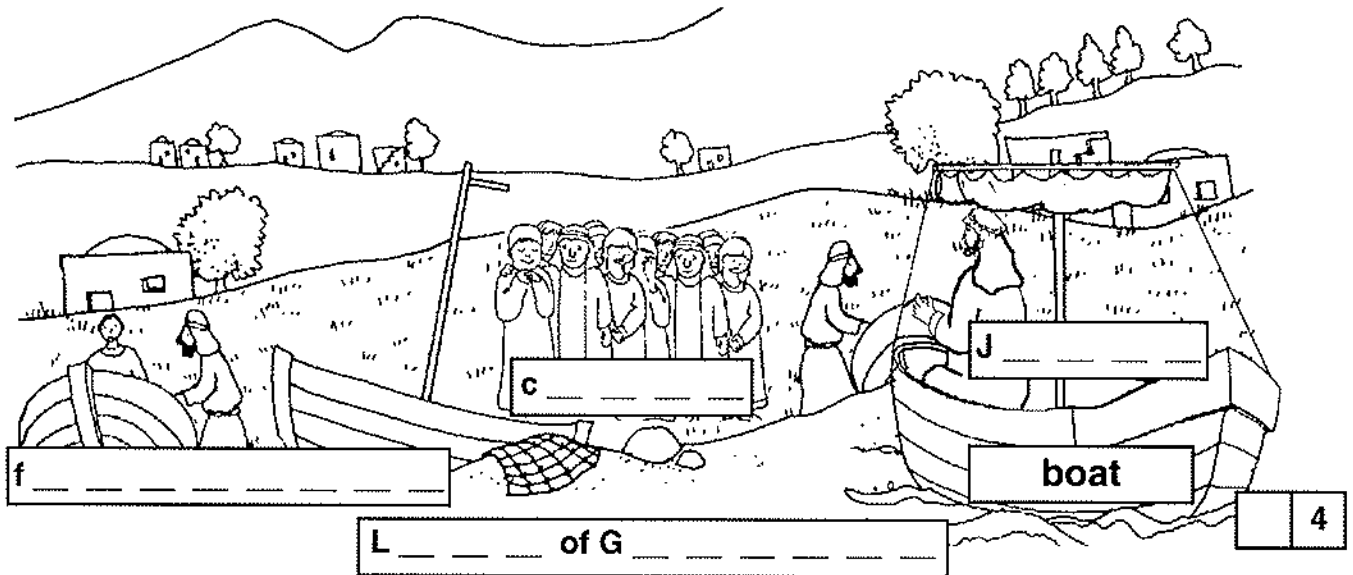
Ask somebody to help you find this verse.

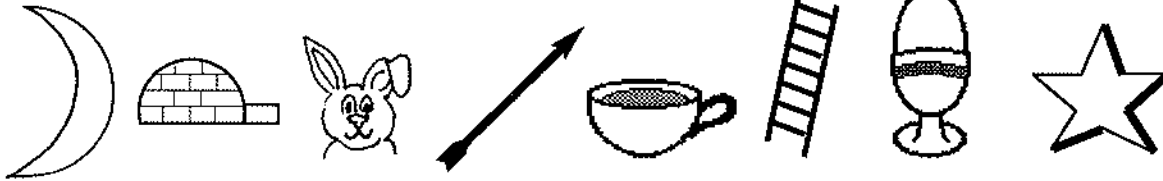
