You can read this story in your Bible:

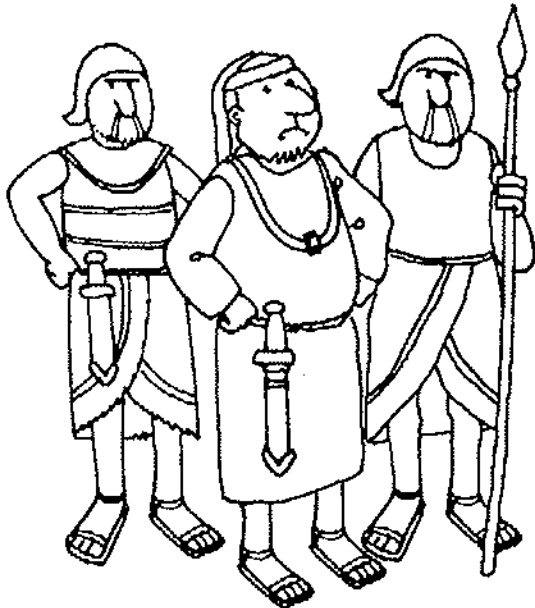
Matthew 26: 47-56

Peter had let the Lord Jesus down by sleeping when he had been asked to pray. Judas, however, had done even worse.

He promised to tell Jesus' enemies where Jesus was, if they would pay him some money. We call this 'betraying'.

Judas betrayed Jesus that night by leading a gang of men through the darkness to capture Jesus.
