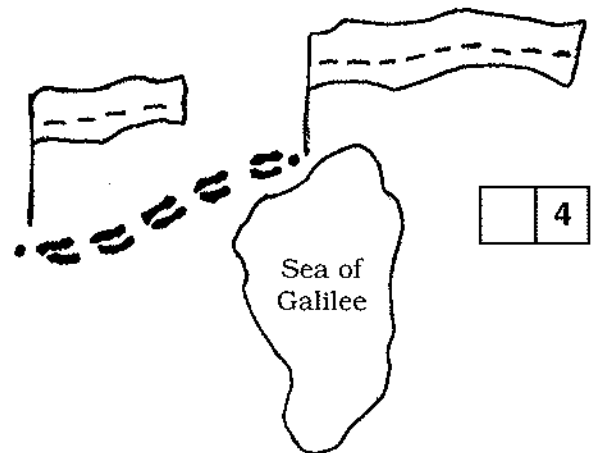

It was a long journey of about 20 miles, but the nobleman didn't complain about the distance. His son was very sick and he wanted to ask Jesus to come to Capernaum to heal him.

How tired and worried the father must have been! The Lord Jesus didn't keep him waiting, or ask him to do something difficult. Instead He simply said:-



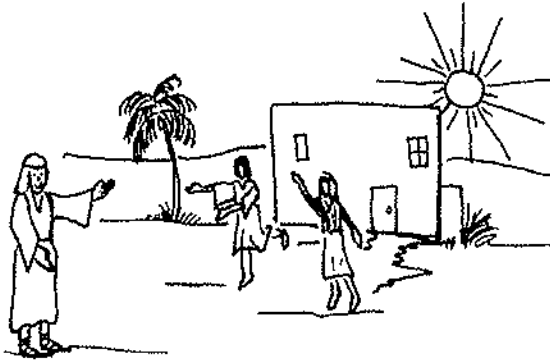
**"Go Your way;
