## Story 2 - Jesus Dies and is Buried.

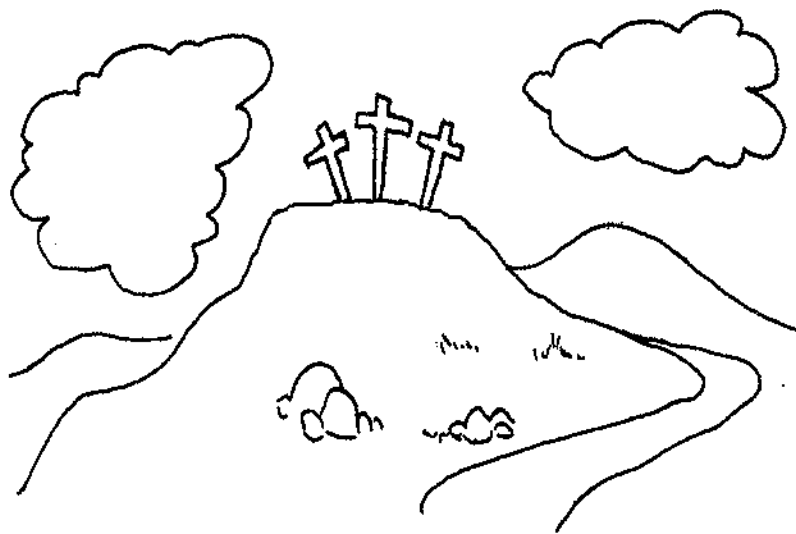
You can read this story in your Bible:



1 Corinthians 15: 3 and 4

It was now the middle of the day. Suddenly the sun stopped shining and it became very dark. This lasted for three hours.

During that time, the Lord Jesus was punished by God for our sin. Although men had already caused Him to suffer a lot of pain, we can not understand just how dreadful this punishment must have been.



Our part is to believe that He suffered for us and to give Him our thanks for His great love.

***We may not know, we cannot tell,  
What pains He had to bear,  
But we believe it was for us,  
He hung and suffered there.***

Finally, after the Lord Jesus had dealt with all our sin, He said, "Father, into Your hands I commit my spirit". This was Jesus' way of saying that He had finished the work His Father had sent Him to do.

It is wonderful to know that He did **everything** that was needed for our sin to be forgiven.

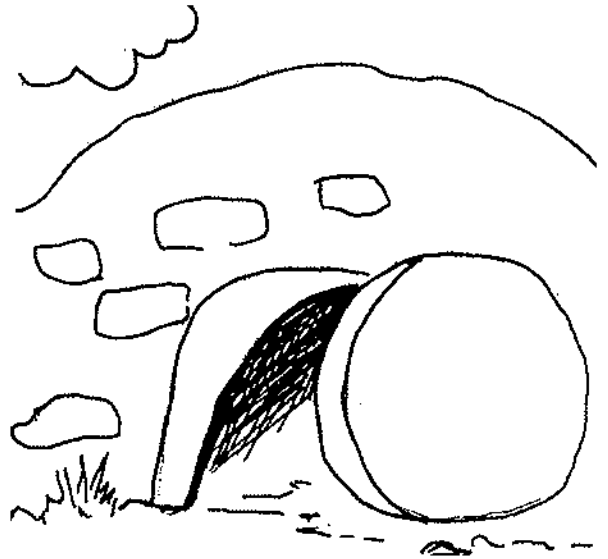
