This time, Joseph was friendly, but still he didn't tell them who he was. He talked to each of them, and especially to Benjamin.

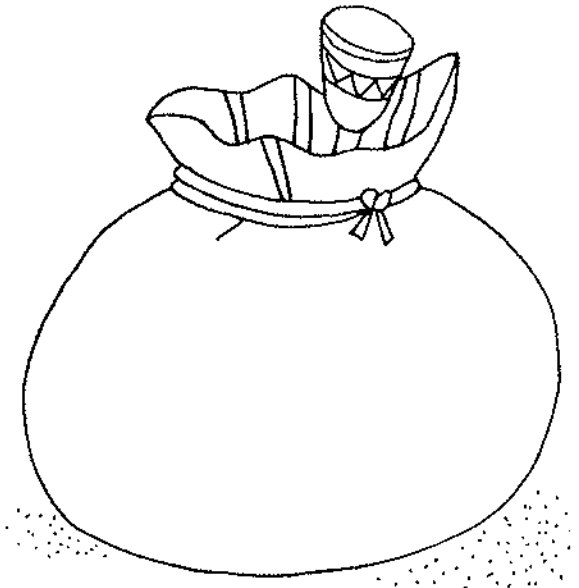
Fill in the missing words in these sentences.
