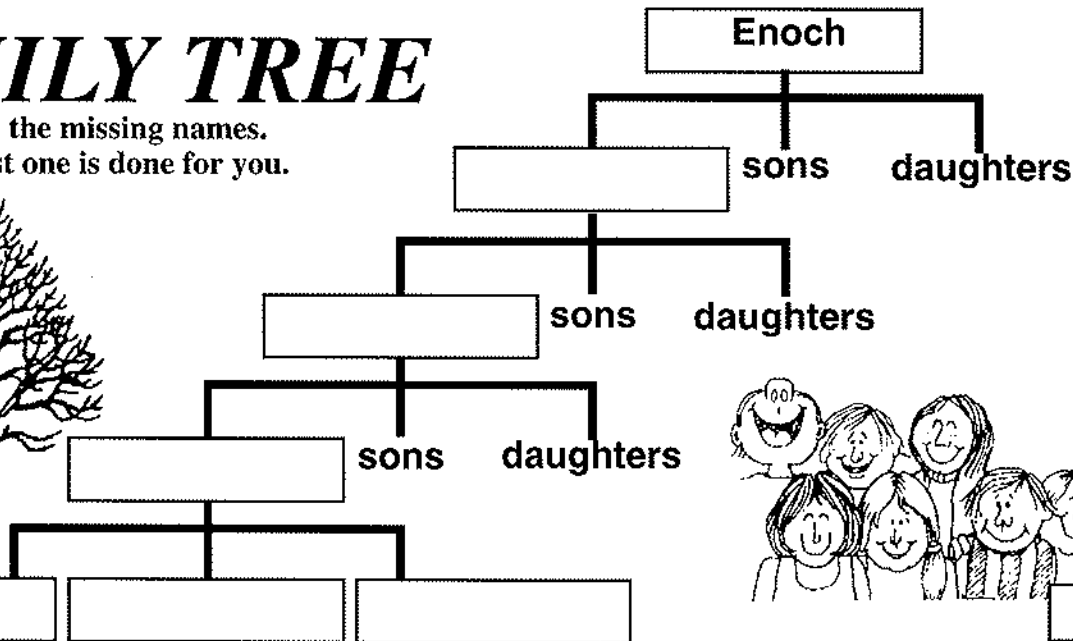
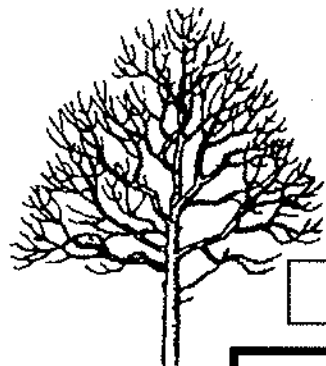


Hebrews 11: 5

What relation was Enoch to Noah?

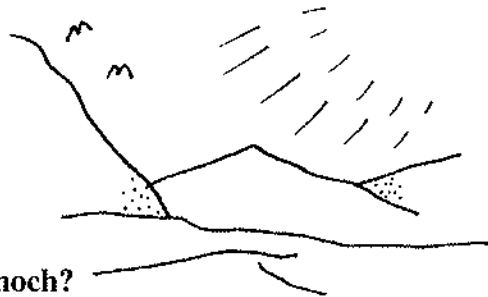

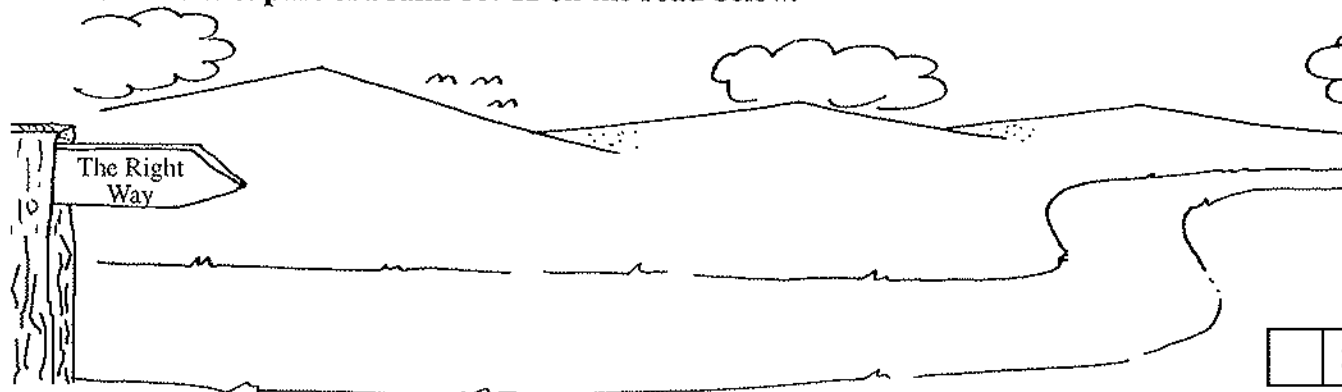
