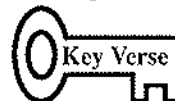

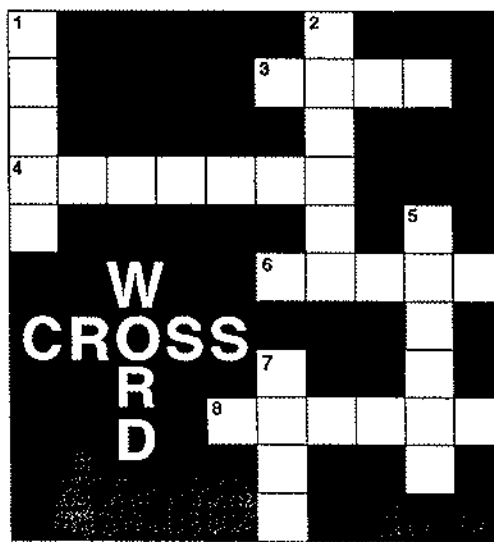
Complete the Crossword to discover the background to this study.
