Do you remember how the last study began? In the church at Jerusalem there was a group of men who were given a special job to do.

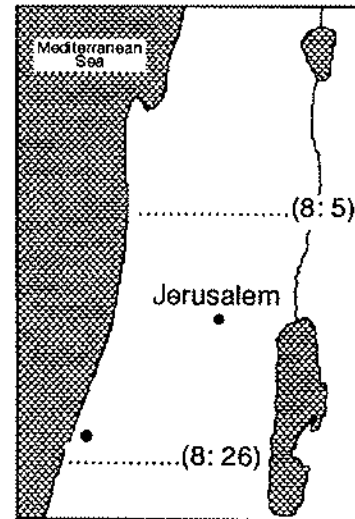
Look back to Acts 6: 5 and find out what that job was, and cross out the incorrect numbers and words in the following sentence:-

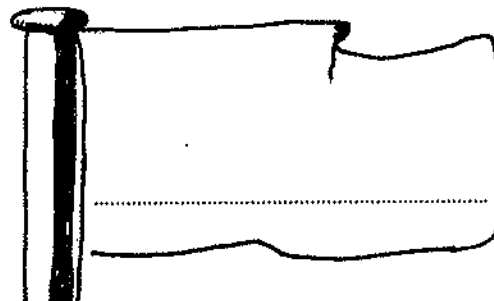
- The people of the city paid close attention to what Philip told them.
