**Lesson No. 3 Abraham's Journeys - God's Promises**

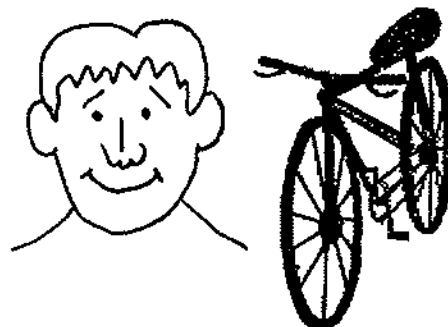

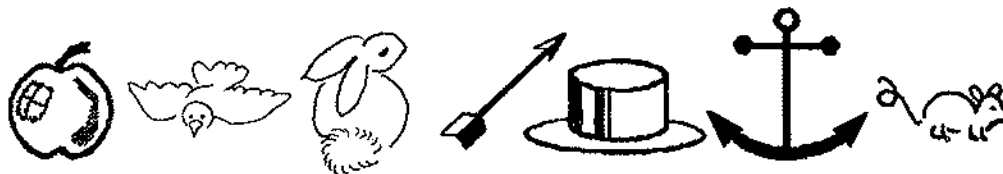

Abram's new name was to be a constant reminder to him of God's promise.

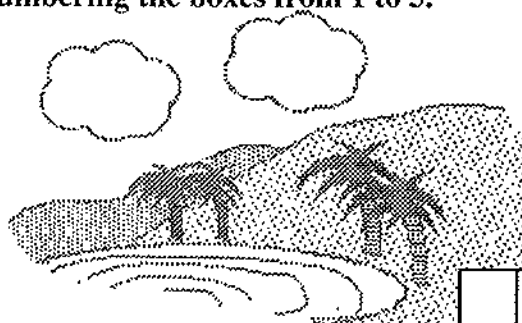
Write down what Genesis 17: 5 tells us about the meaning of his new name.

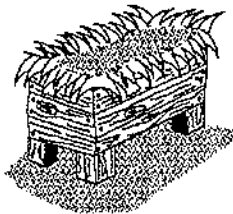
