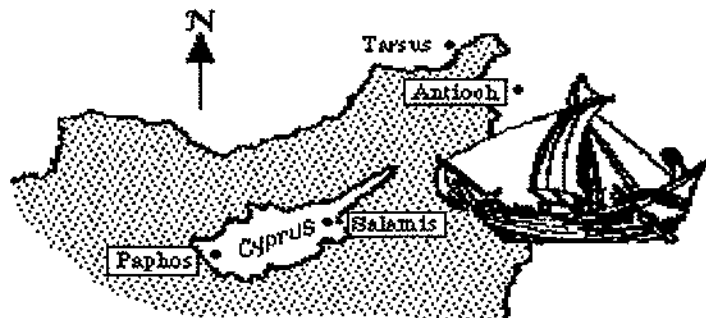

CROSSWORD

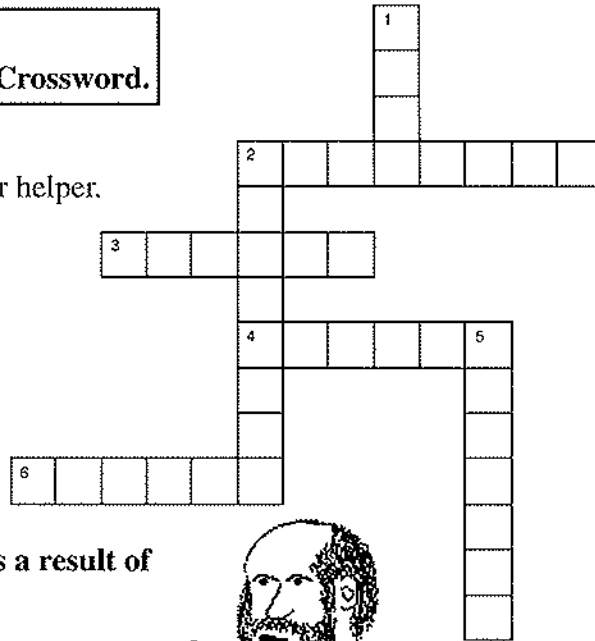
Using words from the Bible Reading, do this Crossword.
