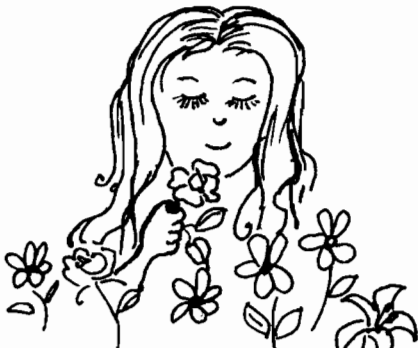

Adam was no longer alone. He now had someone who would be his wife and companion as he looked after the garden in which God had put him.

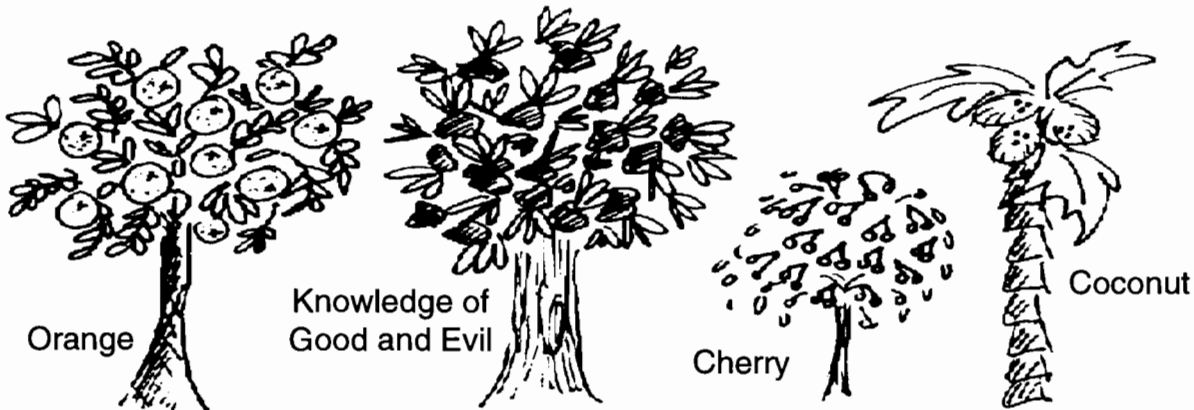
Circle the correct word to complete this sentence.
