2 Corinthians 5: 17

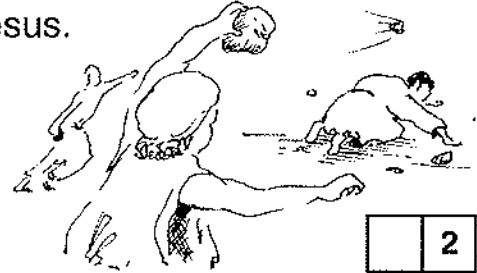

Saul and his friends had almost arrived at the city when suddenly there was a very bright flash of light. Saul was so overcome by it that he fell down to the ground.

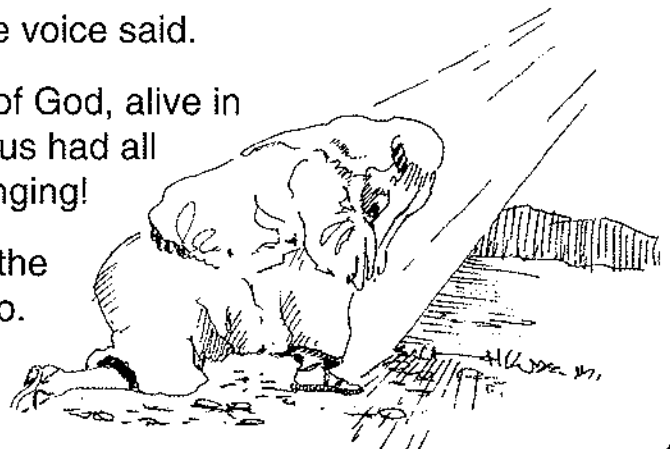
"Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me?" a voice said.

"I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting", the voice said.

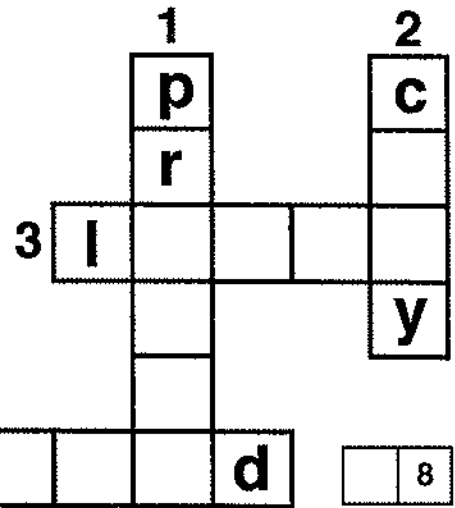
Saul now understood that Jesus is the Son of God, alive in Heaven. Saul's thoughts about the Lord Jesus had all been wrong! How much his life needed changing!

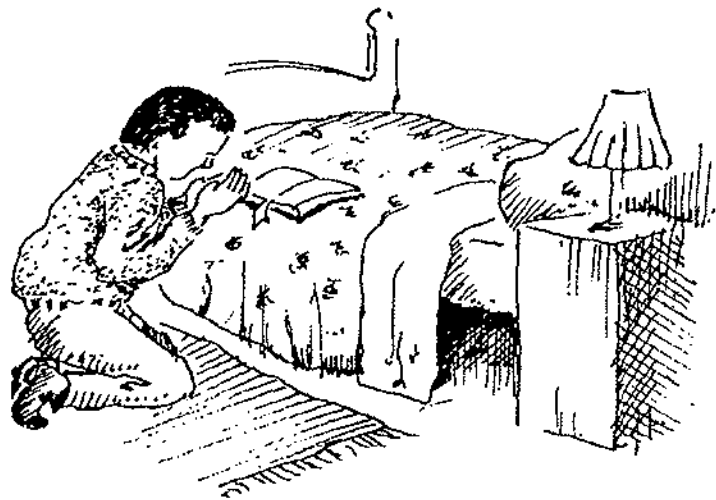
