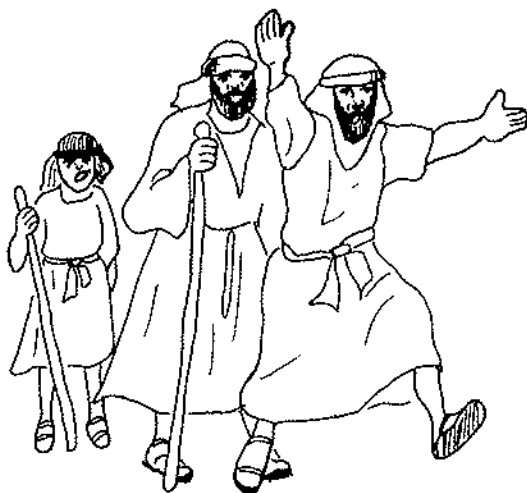

Mark 1: 7

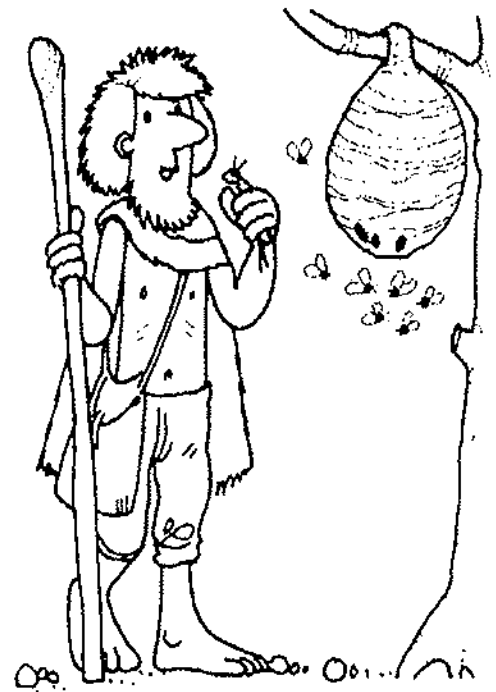
Ask somebody to help you find this verse.
