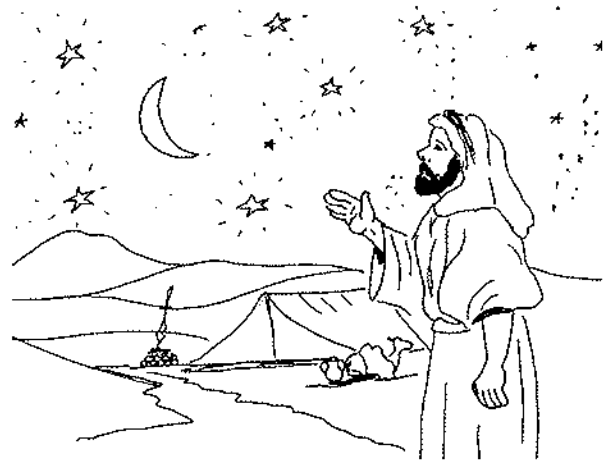


*Genesis 18: 14*
