5. The town where Jesus was born.

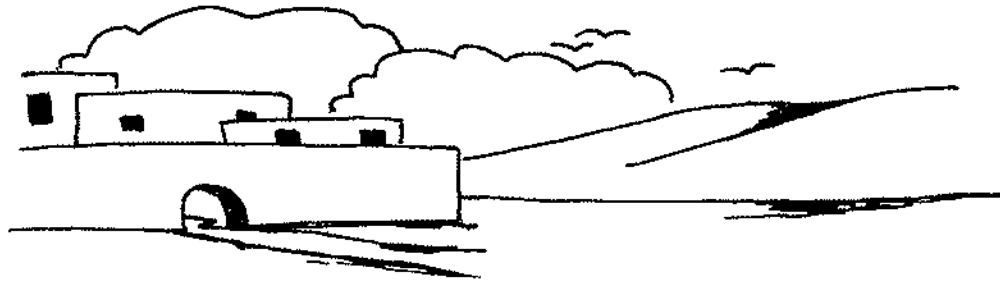
