Lesson No. 4 In The Beginning - Doing things God's Way

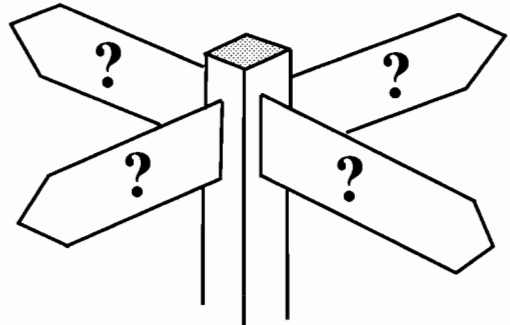

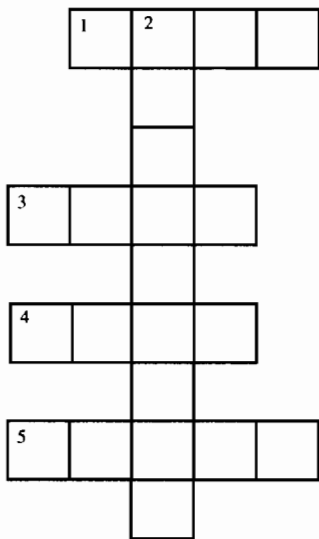


