Strange as it may seem, at this point they did not recognize Him. When He asked them if they had caught anything they said, "No".

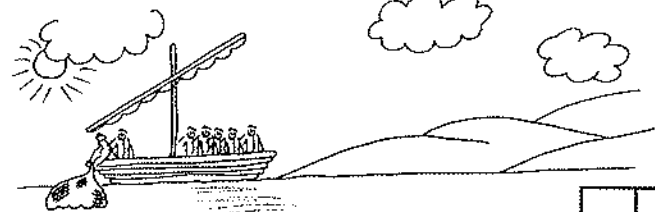
What did He then tell them to do? Underline the correct answer.

As soon as they obeyed His command, they had a great surprise. As their net filled with fish, they realized Who was standing on the shore.

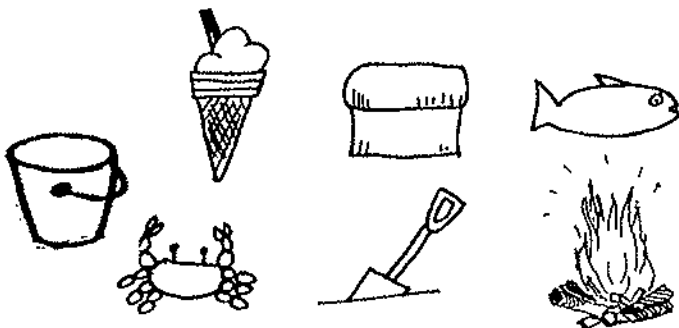

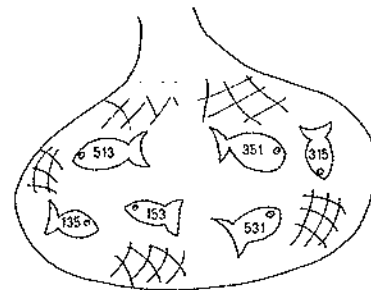
