Lesson No. 4 Miracles - Ten men with leprosy healed

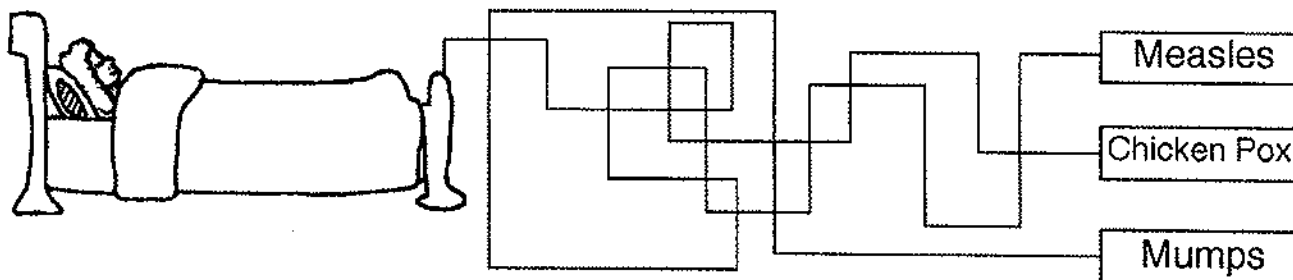


Luke 17: 11-19

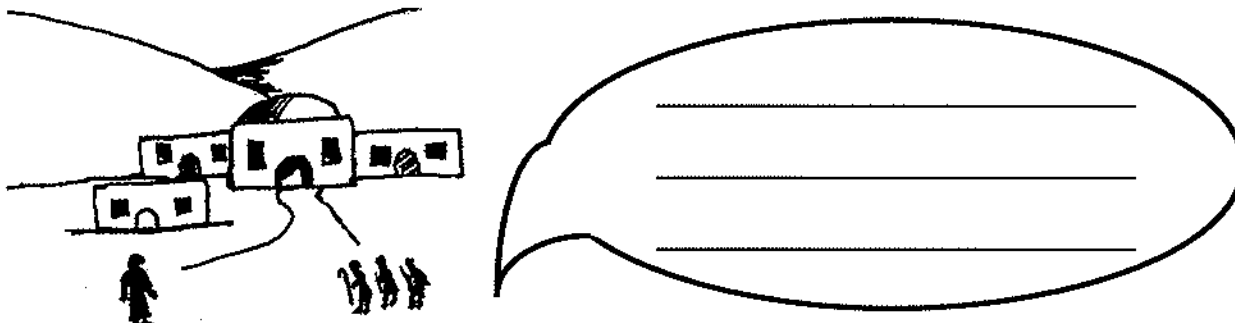


The doctor came to see Becky and it wasn't long before she was completely better.

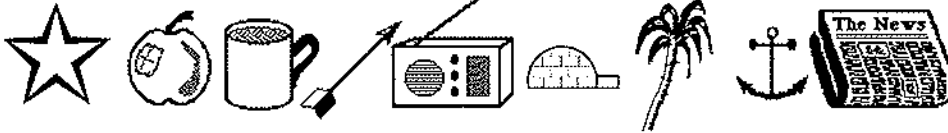

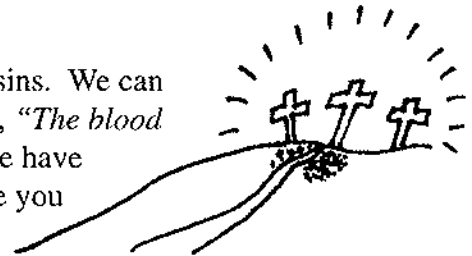
These people were hated by the Jews, yet he was the only one who was thoughtful enough to give thanks to the Lord Jesus. We receive many good things from God. Write down three of these.
