The Lord kept His promises to Jacob and He blessed Joseph too.

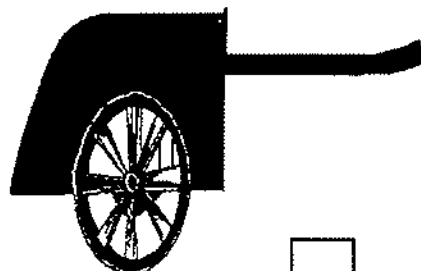
We must always put God first and obey His Word. He has promised to be with us, just like Joseph, even though at times everything may seem very difficult.

God says, "Those who honour Me, I will honour". (1 Samuel 2: 30)

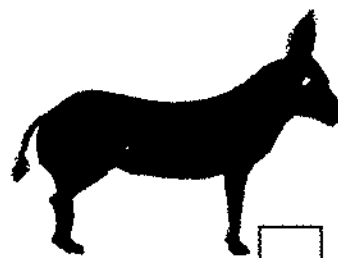
