You can read this story in your Bible:

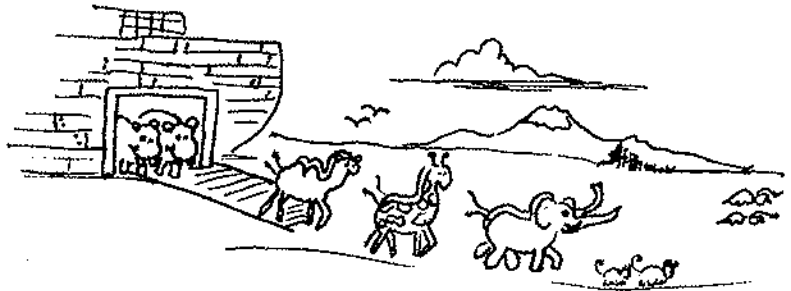


Genesis 9: 15

Noah and his family were safe!

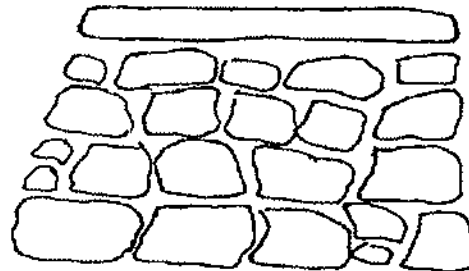
They had been in the Ark for a long time, but now God said that Noah, his family and the animals could leave the Ark.

God was very pleased that Noah and his family remembered to thank Him. He then gave them a wonderful promise.

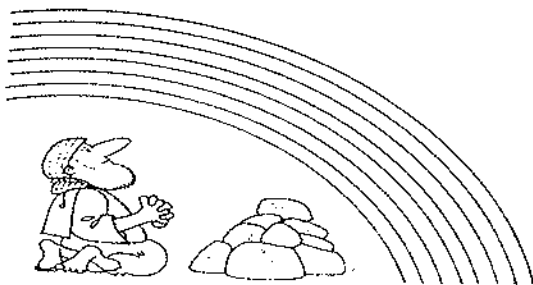

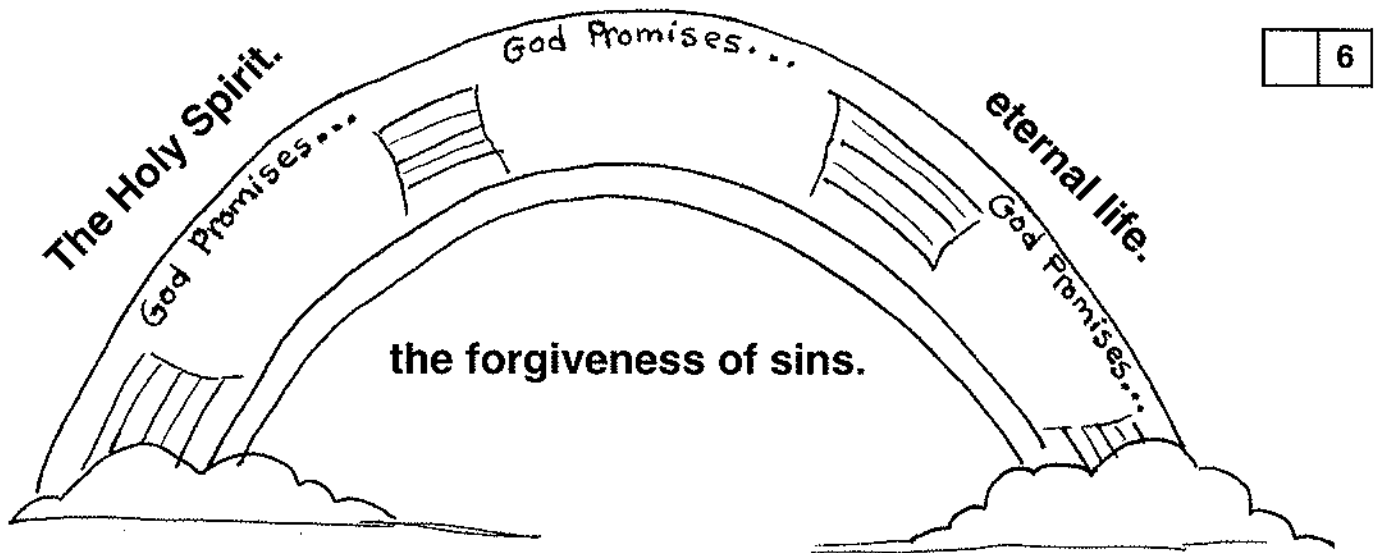
Then God showed them something which was to be a reminder of His promise. It was the rainbow.
