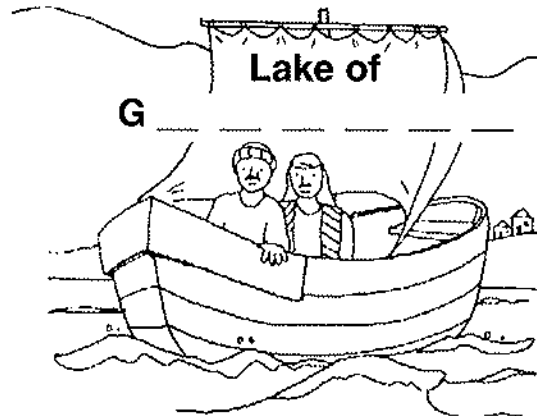

**Put the name of the lake on the sails on the boat.**



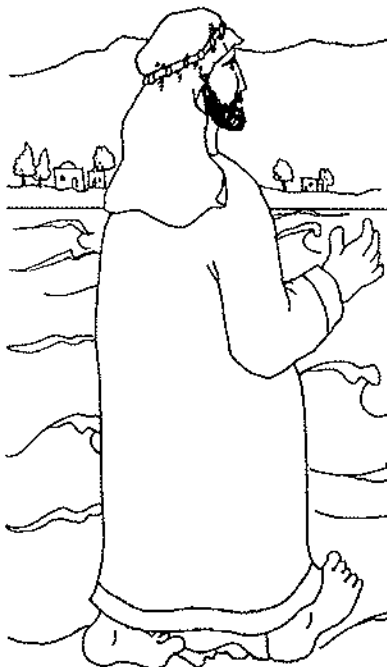
