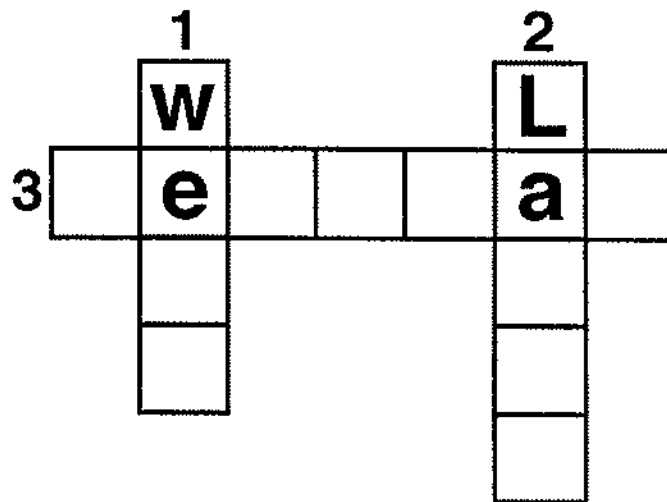
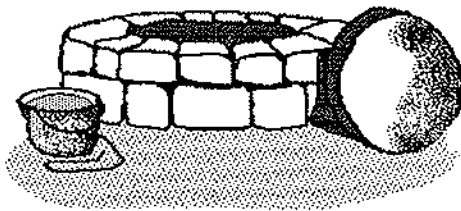
Psalm 144: 15

Write the answers to the following questions on the Word Grid.

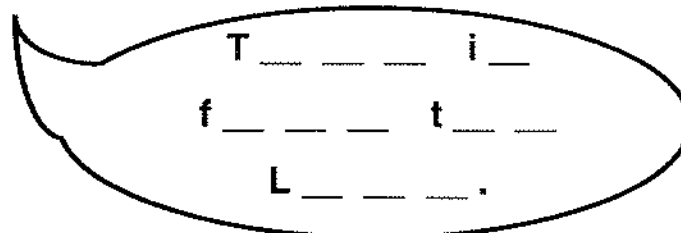
1. Where did Rebekah leave Abraham's servant?

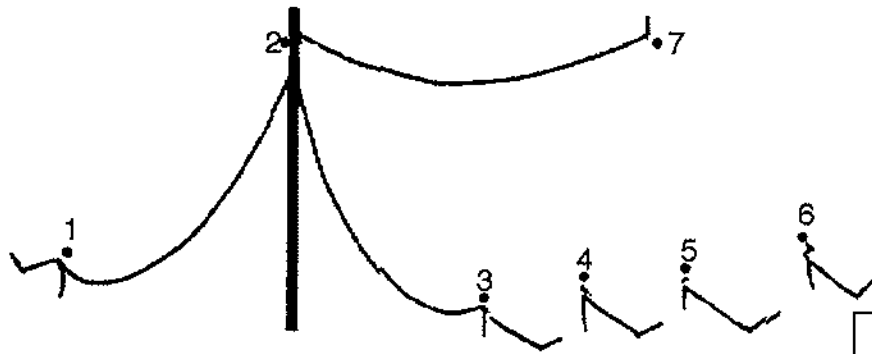
