19: 28- 44**

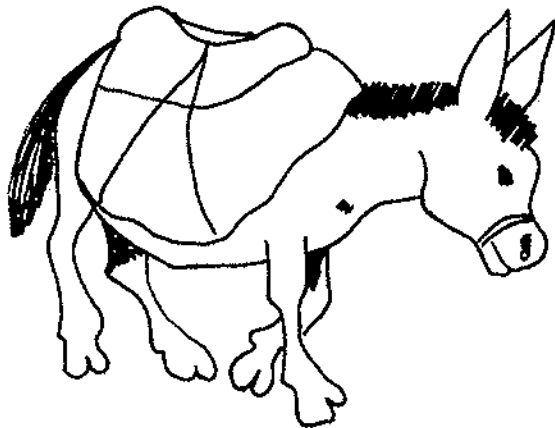


John 1: 12

As He rode along, crowds of people gathered and threw their coats on the road to make a carpet. The crowd became more excited and began praising God. They knew that He was the special King, the One whom God had sent.
