

Story 4 - Paul and Silas in jail.

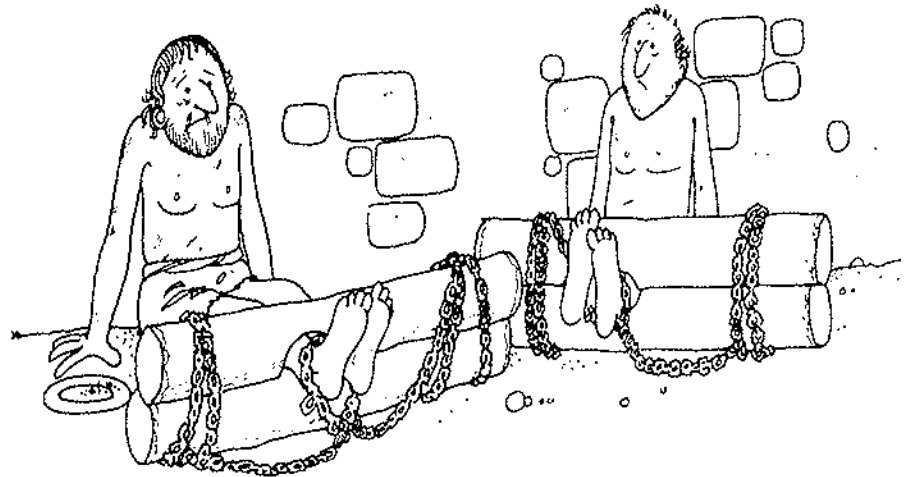
*A true story
