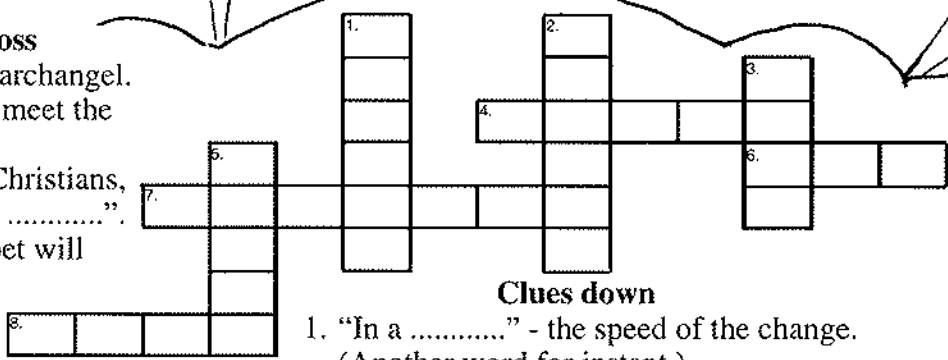
CROSSWORD

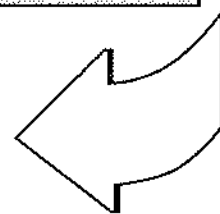
Write out **1 John 2: 28 & 1 John 3: 3** and think carefully about them.
