# Lesson No. 3 Miracles - Blind eyes opened



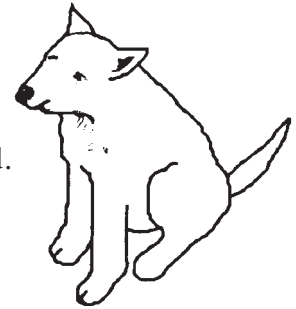
